activity, requiring proper planning prior to work.

Supervisors are responsible to facilitate and/or provide proper
instruction to their workers on protection requirements and training
Hazard analysis

Ensure you are acquainted with ERP.
2. Ensure warning signs/devices are in place.
3. Ensure you are familiar with restraining devices and rigging.
4. Ensure you are familiar with the use of anchors, bridals and
winches.
5. Be familiar with anchoring of pipe/equipment.
6. Ensure you are in view of operator at all times.
7. Ensure you wear appropriate PPE (including high visibility vests).
8. Ensure wheel chocks are utilized.
9. Be aware of rolling boulders or loose rocks.
10. Follow working on hill and on slopes safe work procedure step by
step.
